

Four Year Scholarship 2010/2011

Flathead Electric Co-op offers thirteen \$4,000 general scholarships to seniors graduating from high schools in its service territory. Funds will be distributed at \$1,000 per year for four consecutive years.

Rules

1. Parents or legal guardians of candidates must be members of Flathead Electric Cooperative, and served by the Co-op in their primary residence.
2. Scholarship money must be used to attend an accredited four-year Montana secondary educational institution.
3. Candidates must be in their senior year in high school.
4. Candidates must present the completed application to their guidance counselors with a personal statement* by March 26, 2010. Counselors from each high school will screen applications and present the five most qualified to Flathead Electric by April 2, 2010.
5. Criteria is as follows:

| e. Community activities | 10% |
6. Please attach a certified transcript including SAT/ACT scores.
7. The decision will be made by April 23, 2010. Once approved, a letter indicating enrollment from the Montana school is required by August 27, 2010 before the initial \$1,000 will be delivered to the school. It will be the responsibility of the recipient to contact Flathead Electric for funds in each of the subsequent years with a transcript showing previous years work.
8. The intent of the four-year award is for the education to be continuous. Interruptions may disqualify the recipient from receiving subsequent funds.

*Personal statement should include why you are choosing your future course of study and a paragraph on your statement of need.
