



One-Year Scholarship to **Flathead Valley Community College** 2010/2011

Flathead Electric Co-op offers two \$1,000 scholarships to seniors graduating from a high school in its service territory to attend Flathead Valley Community College. Funds will be distributed at the beginning of the school year. The scholarship is intended to help students pursue a degree or a certificate from FVCC.

Rules

1. Parents or legal guardians of candidates must be members of Flathead Electric Cooperative, and served by the Co-op in their primary residence.
2. Scholarship money must be used to attend Flathead Valley Community College.
3. Candidates must be in their senior year in high school.
4. Candidates must present the completed application to their guidance counselors with a personal statement* by March 26, 2010. Counselors will screen applications and present the three most qualified to Flathead Electric by April 2, 2010.
5. Criteria is as follows:

a. Academic achievement	25%
b. Personal statement	30%
c. Financial need	25%
d. School activities	10%
e. Community activities	10%
6. Please attach a certified transcript including Compass Test or SAT/ACT scores.
7. The decision will be made April 23, 2010. Once approved, a letter indicating enrollment from Flathead Valley Community College is required by August 27, 2010 before any money is delivered to the school. It will be the responsibility of the recipient to contact Flathead Electric for funds prior to attending school.

*Personal statement should include why you are choosing your future course of study and a paragraph on your statement of need.
