

Flathead Electric Cooperative, Inc.RATE SCHEDULE – RES51
RESIDENTIAL SERVICE – Border LoadsAVAILABLE:

In all territory served by Cooperative in the Montana Counties of Carbon and Park.

APPLICABLE:

To all residential services supplied at one point of delivery.

MONTHLY BILLING:

The monthly billing shall be the sum of the Basic Charge and Energy Charge; and applicable Primary Voltage Metering Adjustment, but not less than the Minimum Charge.

<u>Basic Charge:</u>	\$20.78	single phase service, or
	\$39.48	three phase service
<u>Energy Charge:</u>	9.563¢	per kWh for all kWh

MINIMUM CHARGE:

The Minimum Charge shall be the monthly Basic Charge. A higher minimum may be required under contract to cover special conditions.

PRIMARY VOLTAGE METERING ADJUSTMENT:

When a member's service is delivered and metered at the Cooperative's available primary distribution voltage, the sum of the Basic Charge and Energy Charge will be reduced by 1.5%.

CONTINUE SERVICE:

Except as specifically provided otherwise, the rate schedule is based on continuing service at each service location for a period of no less than one year. Disconnect and reconnect transactions shall not operate to relieve a member from Minimum Charge.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Service under this rate schedule is subject to Cooperative Board Policies and Procedures of which this rate schedule is a part.

A residential service provides electric service to premises that have a residential purpose that includes a heated dwelling providing complete, permanent facilities for living, eating, cooking, sleeping and sanitation.

A metered electric service to premises that include a residential purpose and a nonresidential purpose is a residential service when the service includes a residential dwelling and the predominate usage of the metered electric service is for residential purposes. Predominate usage constitutes 50% or more of an electric service's annual energy consumption.

Garages, barns, other outbuildings, wells, pumps, etc. that are served by a separately metered electric service apart from a residential dwelling are excluded from this rate schedule.

Public hotels, motels, camps, lodges, apartments, dormitories, assisted living facilities, shelters, etc. having 5 or more sleeping or living quarters that are served by one metered electric service are excluded from this rate schedule.
