

Flathead Electric Cooperative, Inc.

RATE SCHEDULE – 48
 LARGE INDUSTRIAL SERVICE – NW Loads
 1000 KW AND OVER

AVAILABLE:

In all territory served by Cooperative in Northwest Montana including the Flathead valley and Libby.

APPLICABLE:

This Schedule is applicable to electric service loads which have registered 1,000 kW or more in a consecutive 12-month period. Deliveries at more than one point, or more than one voltage and phase classification, will be separately metered and billed. Service for intermittent, partial requirements, or highly fluctuating loads, or where service is seasonally disconnected during any one-year period will be provided only by special contract for such service.

MONTHLY BILLING:

The Monthly Billing shall be the sum of the Basic, Demand, Energy and Reactive Power Charges; plus applicable Primary Voltage Metering and Delivery Adjustments, but not less than the Minimum Charge.

*Note: kW load size, for the determination of the Basic Charge, shall be the highest non-zero monthly demand established during the 12-month period which includes and ends with the current billing month.

MINIMUM CHARGE:

The minimum monthly charge shall be the Basic Charge plus the Demand Charge. A higher minimum may be required by contract.

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REACTIVE POWER CHARGE:

The maximum 15-minute reactive demand for the month in kilovolt-amperes in excess of 30% of the measured kilowatt demand for the same month will be billed at the Reactive Power Charge referenced above.

PRIMARY VOLTAGE METERING AND DELIVERY ADJUSTMENTS:

The above monthly charges are applicable without adjustment for voltage when delivery and metering are at Cooperative's standard secondary voltage.

Metering: For so long as metering voltage is at Cooperative's available primary distribution voltage, the above charges will be reduced by 1.5%.

Delivery: For so long as delivery voltage is at Cooperative's available primary distribution voltage, the total of the above charges will be reduced as indicated under Load Size Discount on a per kW of demand billed in the month.

The reductions of charges herein shall not operate to reduce Minimum Charges for the first 800 kW.

When a new or existing member requests delivery of power that requires a Cooperative-owned transformer(s) at a voltage other than a locally standard distribution voltage, the above charges for any month will be increased by 15¢ per kW of demand billed in the month.

Cooperative retains the right to change its line voltage or classifications thereof at any time, and after reasonable advance notice to any member affected by such change, such member then has the option to take service at the new line voltage or to accept service through transformers to be supplied by Cooperative subject to the voltage adjustments above.

DEMAND:

Demand shall be the greater of:

- (a) The measured kW shown by or computed from the readings of Cooperative's demand meter for the 15-minute period of member's greatest use during the month, determined to the nearest one-tenth of a kW, or
- (b) 800 kW

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SPECIAL CONDITIONS:

Customer shall not resell electric service received from Cooperative under provisions of this schedule to any person, except by written permission of Cooperative and where customer meters and bills any of his tenants at Cooperative's regular tariff rate for the type of service which such tenant may actually receive.

TERM OF CONTRACT:

Cooperative may require the customer to sign a written contract which shall have a term of not less than one year.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Service under this schedule is subject to Cooperative Board Policies of which this schedule is a part.
