TARIFF SCHEDULE – 5
 SMALL GENERAL SERVICE – Border Loads
 LESS THAN 30 KW

AVAILABLE:

In all territory served by Cooperative in southern Montana along the Montana-Wyoming border.

APPLICABLE:

To residential and commercial customers with single-phase electric requirements, less than 30 kW usage and all service is supplied at one point of delivery. For three-phase service provisions see Schedule 18.

MONTHLY BILLING:

The Monthly Billing shall be the sum of the Basic and Energy Charges, but not less than the Minimum Charge.

MINIMUM CHARGE:

The minimum monthly charge shall be the Basic Charge. A higher minimum may be required under contract to cover special conditions.

CONTINUING SERVICE:

Except as specifically provided otherwise, the rates of this tariff are based on continuing service at each service location for a period of no less than one year. Disconnect and reconnect transactions shall not operate to relieve a customer from monthly minimum charge.

RULES AND REGULATIONS:

Service under this schedule is subject to Cooperative Board Policies of which this schedule is a part.
